



SUPERVISORY TEACHER'S ACTIVE STATUS POLICY AGREEMENT

This Agreement is between The Energy Extension, Inc. (hereafter referred to as “EEI”), an Arizona corporation with its principal offices being located in Sedona, AZ, USA, and the EMF Balancing Technique® Supervisory Teacher (hereafter referred to as the “Supervisory Teacher”) and is effective as of the date on the signature page, which is the “Effective Date” of this Agreement.

Purpose

The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth certain policies to be followed by all Supervisory Teachers who have received training in the EMF Balancing Technique® from Peggy Phoenix Dubro, originator of the technique. The intent of this agreement is to provide a uniform system of policies and ethics for all Supervisory Teachers, to maintain and advance the integrity and potency of the EMF Balancing Technique®, and among other considerations, to maintain and advance the value of its certificates.

This is also intended to be a legally binding agreement and all Supervisory Teachers are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with the policies and the spirit of the policies set forth herein, keeping in mind that such policies may be added to, deleted or modified at EEI's sole discretion, when and should the need arise.

Failure to comply with the current policies may result in suspension and/or revocation of the Teacher's rights and certification as defined in the policies.

Copyrights and Trademarks

The terms “EMF Balancing Technique®” and “Universal Calibration Lattice®” are protected by United States and International copyright and trademark laws and are only to be used in accordance with the written agreements between the Practitioner and EEI, or as EEI may otherwise allow in writing.

Teacher Obligations

Each phase of the EMF Balancing Technique® must be taught as described in the EMF Practitioners' manuals. All steps must be taught in each phase, and in the proper sequence. *Movements may not be added to or subtracted from the procedure.*

In accordance with the essential goal of an EMF session, which is to allow the inner wisdom of each client to shine forth, an EMF Supervisory Teacher will always honor the unique nature of each student.

The Supervisory Teacher must honor the policies and procedures outlined in this agreement. If a Supervisory Teacher no longer wishes to teach the EMF Balancing Technique® as required by this agreement, or in any way alters the set procedure of the

EMF Balancing Technique, it is incumbent upon the Teacher to so advise EEI, return any property that belongs to EEI, and sign a release relinquishing all rights as described in this agreement.

The intent of the previous section is to ensure that a student who comes to an EMF Balancing Technique Supervisory Teacher in any part of the world for an EMF Balancing Technique Training learns the same procedure. If a Supervisory Teacher modifies the technique in any way, then he/she may not represent themselves as a Supervisory Teacher of the EMF Balancing Technique, nor use the name “EMF Balancing Technique” to describe what they are doing.

Training Requirements

PERSONAL GROWTH PROGRAM

Personal Growth Training - Evolution of Consciousness

Duration: 6 days

Prerequisite: None - open to all

A full training requires a minimum of six days, or thirty-three (33) hours of *teaching time*.

The UCL workshop is a prerequisite for the rest of the training. The four phases must be taught sequentially. The training does not have to be given in six consecutive days. We encourage you to spread it out over a series of weekends. Adding extra time is encouraged.

Minimum format:

Universal Calibration Lattice Workshop - One day

Phase I - One day

Phase II - One day

Phase III - One day

Phase IV - Two days

Deposits:

When the deposit is given, it is an expression of a sincere intent to take the class, and is the first step in making the alignments with the work. (Self-responsibility!) Please obtain deposits for your classes - the statement you make by requesting a deposit is that this work is valuable, and that your time and your students time are valuable.

PROFESSIONAL PATH PROGRAM

Accredited Practitioner Internship

Duration: 3 months to 1 year

Prerequisite: completion of Personal Growth Training

All other fees, such as for entry-level workshops or informational evenings, adult education classes, private sessions, mini sessions, etc. are at the discretion of the Supervisory Teacher.

Supervisory Teachers Rights

An EMF Supervisory Teacher may teach the first four phases of the EMF Balancing Technique[®], those being Phases I, II, III and IV.

Supervisory Teachers who have been certified by EEI have the right to use the name “EMF Balancing Technique[®] Supervisory Teacher.” No phase of the EMF Balancing Technique[®] may be taught by anyone other than a Supervisory Teacher of the EMF Balancing Technique[®], nor does anyone else have the right to use the name “EMF Balancing Technique[®] Supervisory Teacher.”

The use of EEI materials in advertising is allowed, including material from the website www.EMFWorldwide.com, but is subject to certain conditions. These conditions include, but are not necessarily limited to the following:

- Official brochures (where available) may be ordered from EEI so as to ensure continuity in its message and global identity.
- All brochures or advertising created independently must be submitted to EEI for written approval, which shall be at EEI’s sole discretion.
- The complete name “EMF Balancing Technique[®]” (including the registered symbol) is to appear in any advertising, and must be the prominent feature of the advertisement. For example, explanations or subtitles, such as electromagnetic field balancing, should appear in a smaller font size.
- When you use the name “EMF Balancing Technique[®]” in any internet advertising, you must include a link or reference to www.EMFWorldwide.com.

- When you use the name “EMF Balancing Technique®” in any other advertising medium, you must include a reference to www.EMFWorldwide.com and/or the telephone number of the worldwide office in Sedona, Arizona, USA. (+1-928-284-3703)
- You may use the name “EMF Balancing Technique®” without any reference to the Official website or home office when it is being used solely to describe yourself as a practitioner of the technique, for example, in a directory listing.

Guideline for Introductory Workshops other than the UCL (Supervisory Teachers)

An introductory, or informational workshop should be appropriately named so it is a vehicle to introduce prospective clients or students to the benefits of a session or of the training. We suggest that you call it “An Introduction to understanding the energy of an EMF Balancing Technique® Session”, or an “Introduction to the benefits of becoming an EMF Practitioner”.

(This will distinguish it from the “Universal Calibration Lattice Workshop”, which is really the first day of the basic training.) In an Introductory workshop, you may demonstrate a mini session, and you may also pass on any of the information pertaining to the Universal Calibration Lattice. You may discuss information relevant to the intents and benefits of any of the four sessions. We do not suggest that you teach the mini session, but you may offer mini sessions for a fee (or at no cost).

An Information Workshop can be 1-3 hours, but cannot replace any part of the UCL Workshop. In other words, anyone who participates in your Information Workshop must still complete the entire UCL Workshop.

Guideline for Introductory Workshops other than the UCL (Accredited Practitioners)

(This section is taken from the Accredited Practitioners policies, and is included here to clarify the difference between an introductory workshop authorized for Accredited Practitioners vs an introductory workshop authorized for Teachers.)

An Accredited Practitioner’s introductory workshop should be appropriately named so it is a vehicle to introduce prospective clients to the benefits of an EMF session. A suggested title might be “An Introduction to Understanding the Energy of an EMF Balancing Technique® Session.”

An Accredited Practitioner must understand that he/she may perform the EMF Balancing Technique® on others and talk about its benefits. However, only a Supervisory Teacher is allowed to teach the technique to others.

In an Accredited Practitioner’s introductory workshop, **the Accredited Practitioner may not demonstrate a full session or pass on any of the symbols. The Accredited Practitioner may not teach the Mini Session to a group. This role is reserved for Supervisory Teachers.**

While individuals may learn the mini session from the tape set, the Accredited Practitioner may only demonstrate a Mini Session to a group. He/she may pass on any of the information pertaining to the Universal Calibration Lattice. The Accredited Practitioner may discuss information relevant to the intents and benefits of any of the four sessions.

Exit Policy

We recognize and honor each individual and their growth. We provide an exit policy as a way to honor both EEI and the Supervisory Teacher. If at any time you decide that you no longer resonate with the current policies of the EMF Balancing Technique[®], we ask that you obtain a Release Form by contacting EEI at the address on the signature page.

Active Status Requirements

1. A current class schedule including at least two classes per year must be posted on the official EMF website www.EMFWorldwide.com. In addition to your scheduled classes, teaching by appointment is a listing option. There are no charges for class listings.
2. Submit a Bio excerpt for your free web listing, using the new guidelines for Supervisory Teacher's bios.
3. All web listings must contain a statement from the Supervisory Teacher providing their reason for teaching the EMF Balancing Technique. This statement can be part of the bio excerpt, or if a Supervisory Teacher prefers a listing without a bio, then the statement will stand in place of the bio excerpt.
4. Read, sign, and submit the updated Supervisory Teacher policies.

Instructions for the signature page:

It is the intent of the Energy Extension, Inc. to continue to develop these policies along with a code of ethics appropriate for the continued growth of the EMF work.
